Hi Iben

1. No joins at all
2. All underlays and carpet will help with sound proofing, but there is a better underlay that is more recommended for sound reduction which will cost you an extra £140 for the 4 bedrooms
3. All cut pile carpets will eventually show tracking, but it will take time with the Lulworth as it is closely woven
4. These carpets can be joined OK at doorways, but not all carpets are suitable, so it depends on the landing carpet that you have already
5. We do have cheaper, hard wearing, carpets that are used for offices etc. which will be suitable for the gym
