

CARE AND MAINTENANCE GUIDE FOR OIL & WAX FLOORS

- Make sure the floor is free from loose dirt and dust using a broom, brush or vacuum cleaner.
- For regular wet cleaning use an oil based wash and care product together with a damp mop or cloth, diluted in water depending on level of soiling. For larger floors, use a second bucket with warm clear water for rinsing mop/cloth. For stubborn stains, rub with a soft pad moistened with cleaner then wipe with a cloth.
- If regular cleaning is not effective, use an intensive cleaner diluted with warm water with a rotary buffer in larger areas. For stubborn stains apply undiluted cleaner and wipe repeatedly with clear water. Be careful not to use too much water. Once floor has dried, refinish with protective wax oil or finish oil.
- Heavy wear, stubborn marks such as burns, paint marks and scratches can be partially repaired using a high grit abrasive pad or sandpaper, making sure you follow the grain of the wood. 150-180 grit abrasive will be sufficient for this. Use 220-240 grit to remove traces of the sanding. Remove all dust produced by the sanding procedure and then apply a new coat of hardwax or protective wax oil.
- Always protect your floor from grit and dirt by placing mats in entrance areas and fit moveable furniture with felt gliders.
