

Memo - New Stock Ancillaries

Stairrods have produced a tile or wood edge to cover the edge of fitted wood or tiled floors without a proper edge finish being installed by the builder when installing the wood or tile floors. They are a good option where tiled floors are significantly higher than the adjacent sub floor where we are fitting carpets.

COVERAGE OF FACE OF TILES

When used in conjunction with a carpet fitted on gripper they can be used either instead of easy shims, for tiles from 12 - 18mm high (plus pile height of carpet selected) or in conjunction with a 12mm easy shims for tiles up to 28mm (plus pile height of carpet selected).

They can be sold like the door bars in 900mm multiples up to a maximum length of 2.7m

They are £22.00 per 900mm length but I think we should charge £5.00 per door fitting charge and pay the fitter £3.00 per door length for fitting as they are more involved than standard door bars.

If the tiles are either very rough or uneven on the surface it may be necessary to also sell a tube of clear mastic to stick the lips to uneven floors in these circumstances.

They are under F4 stock ancillaries as below and available as soon as they appear under F4 as a selection

Premier Trim Lip



- The Premier Lips are a versatile section with many uses.
- Use it as a tile edge or to create a mat well. It will form a tidy edge against your french window or use it as a Scotia where the flooring is 10mm deep or over.
- Used in combination with our Shims the lips will allow you to deal with a height difference at a doorway of up to 35mm.

We are now stocking Premier lips in Polished Chrome and a Satin Chrome finish.

(The finishes we are stocking are actually the Chrome and Satin Nickel as this colour was closest to the Nisheen bars and a better match than the Satin chrome finish option).

They are in stock in 2.7m lengths like the door bars but we are selling them in multiples of a standard 900mm length and they will be cut down at the warehouse from the longer lengths in stock

**The retail price for either finish is £22.00 per 900mm length
EXCLUDING FITTING**

It is option 1 (one) we are stocking (tape under top face for surface sticking to tile or wood edge) but if the surface is very rough or uneven we may need to sell a tube of clear silicone to level or stick them to an uneven surface.



Technical



Product

- The Premier Lips range of edges are a high quality stick down product for a high quality installation.
- The Premier Lips range are available in nine colours and three lengths: 90cm, 180cm and 270cm. See facing page for details.
- The Premier Lips range can be used for a 'Non Porous' ceramic edge, wood edge, french window edge, room edge and when used with our shims
- The lips will come fitted with Tape Option 1 unless otherwise stated. Other tape options are 2 and 3, see below for description and situation suitability.

Fitting Tape Option 1

- This fitting option is for where the front face of the edge is rough or uneven but the top face is smooth and able to provide a good surface for the tape to stick.

Fitting Tape Option 2

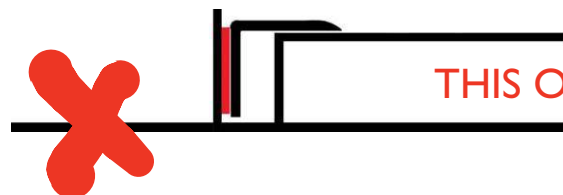
- This fitting option is for where the top face of the edge is rough or uneven but the front face is smooth and able to provide a good surface for the tape to stick.

Fitting Tape Option 3

- This fitting option is for a room edge where the Lip would be attached to the skirting and protrude into the room to cover the expansion joint of laminate or engineered flooring deeper than 10mm. It can also be used to cover an untidy tile edge, for example around a kitchen floor.

Care and Maintenance

- Satin Brass and Polished Brass Trims can be left to age (oxidise) for a natural finish. However to keep the brass like new these two finishes will need to be polished from time to time with a propriety brass polish. Ensure that you follow the instructions on the tin and protect your flooring during polishing.
- Satin Nickel, Chrome, and Brushed Chrome These finishes will need to be polished from time to time with a propriety metal polish. Ensure that you follow the instructions on the tin and protect your flooring during polishing.
- Pewter, Antique Bronze and Antique Brass If these finishes become contaminated the only option is to polish them with a propriety metal polish and allow them to age again naturally. Ensure that you follow the instructions on the tin and protect your flooring during polishing.
