Everything we produce is designed and made in Scandinavia using the best sustainable New Zealand Wool that is the whitest and cleanest available. This ensures excellent levelness of colour when dyed and gives us the ability to make beautiful pastel shades and brighter light colours including white.

- We only use renewable energy from offshore wind farms to power our factories
