GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Scope of application

1. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, all our contractual relations with the customer are exclusively subject to these general terms and conditions to the exclusion of the general terms and conditions of the customer.

Offers - Orders - Order confirmations

2.1. All our sales are deemed to have been concluded at Mouscron. Our representatives, commercial agents or any other agents or employees are not authorized to bind us or to collect payments. Our offers are without obligation and do not bind us. Orders only give rise to a sales contract after our written order confirmation.

2.2. The inclusion of an article in our collection in no way obliges us to continue or resume its production if this article has meanwhile been discontinued, whether with or without a notice period.

2.3. Upon receipt of our order confirmation, the purchaser is obliged to check this in detail. Any errors in the order confirmation must be reported in writing to our customer service department within 48 hours under penalty of inadmissibility.

Delivery of goods/services

3.1. The goods are deemed to have been accepted at Mouscron and travel at the risk of the customer even if shipped carriage paid.

3.2. Delivery times are only approximate, even if they have been stipulated by agreement. In the event of an abnormal delay in delivery, the customer shall be entitled, except in cases of force majeure or regularisation by us within 30 days of a registered notice of default, to cancel the order in writing without either party being able to claim compensation. Force majeure is understood to be danger of war or war, strikes, lockout, traffic or transport disruptions, disruptions in (data) networks, government measures, scarcity of raw materials, exceptional weather conditions, fire and all other circumstances beyond our control that hinder the normal course of our activities.

Indemnity for defects and other guarantees

4.1. The customer undertakes to receive the sold goods immediately upon delivery and to examine whether the quality and/or quantity of the delivered goods corresponds to what was agreed. In the event of damage to the packaging of the goods or transport damage, the customer must indicate this on the transport document and delivery order, and report this to us with accompanying photographs within 48 hours of delivery under penalty of inadmissibility of any complaint. The damaged goods delivered by UPS or another courier must be made available by the customer for 14 days for the courier to investigate the complaint on the premises.

4.2. Visible defects, other than the aforementioned transport damage, must be reported to us in writing within 8 days after delivery under penalty of inadmissibility, before any processing, cutting or placement, even of a part thereof, has taken place. The customer explicitly acknowledges that the cutting, processing or placement of the delivered goods or a part thereof is exclusively at his own risk and entails the irrevocable acceptance of the goods. Defective goods can only be returned after our express written consent and provided that they have been correctly packed in order to avoid damage during and through transport.

4.3. If a carpet is produced especially for the customer (own design, own colour or own measurements), a maximum tolerance of 10% is always applied for deliveries < 200m², 5% for deliveries < 500 m² and 3% for deliveries > 1000 m² for large widths. A maximum tolerance of 10% is always applied for deliveries < 50LM and 5% for deliveries > 50LM for narrow widths. This means that we are entitled to invoice the quantity delivered if it is greater than the quantity ordered, but with a maximum increase of the aforementioned tolerance.

SHADING (PILE REVERSAL) : All cut-pile carpets may be subject to a physical effect which is called "shading". Shading occurs as a permanent local change in the pile direction. Shading creates shadow effects in the carpet in various places. This phenomenon is not caused by a manufacturing defect and therefore does not constitute a defect that can trigger our liability.

4.4. A hidden defect must be reported to us and substantiated in writing by the customer within 8 days of its discovery, under penalty of forfeiture of recourse. In addition, the legal claim based on a hidden defect must be brought within 12 months of delivery under penalty of forfeiture.

4.5. Under no circumstances can we be held liable if the defects are the result of a fault on the part of the customer such as improper storage, handling, abnormal use or lack of maintenance, incorrect placement, stains resulting from the use of inadequate cleaning products, etc., without this list being exhaustive. Due to differences in the dye baths, the colour of a produced carpet can always deviate from the sample so that we cannot accept complaints regarding colour differences.

4.6. If the complaint is well-founded, our obligations shall, at our discretion, be limited to the replacement or repair of the defective goods, without the customer being entitled to compensation. In the absence of repair or replacement, our liability shall in any case be limited to the invoiced price of the goods, to the exclusion of any other compensation, including for the removal of the defective goods and/ or the placement of new goods. In case of replacement, we cannot guarantee that the new goods originate from the same production lot as the defective goods. We are not responsible for static electricity or the transformation of goods as a result of climate conditions.

Payment

5.1. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, our invoices are payable in cash without discount at our registered office. Offering bills of exchange does not constitute a novation of debt and does not change the place of payment. Discount and bank charges, all collection and protest costs of accepted or non-accepted bills of exchange, postal delivery cards and other costs are at the expense of the customer.

5.2. From the due date of the invoices, the amount due shall automatically, and without prior notice of default, bear interest on arrears at the same rate as the interest rate applicable pursuant to the Act of 2 August 2002 on combating late payment in commercial transactions (Late Payment Law) with a minimum of 8.5% per annum.

5.3. In the event of total or partial non-payment on the due date without serious and recognised reasons, in addition to the amount due, a fixed payment of 10% of the total invoice debt with a minimum of £ 104 and a maximum of £ 2085 shall be due by operation of law and without prior notice of default, even in the event of granting grace periods.

5.4. In the event of non-payment of an invoice on its due date or protest by an accepted bill of exchange, all invoices or bills of exchange that are still due shall become immediately due and payable by operation of law and without prior notice of default.

5.5. In the event of late payment or non-payment of one or more invoices or bills of exchange on the due date, we reserve the right to suspend further deliveries without prior notice of default.

5.6. In the event of the publication of a bill of exchange protest, in liquidation, cessation of payment - even if not officially established - or any other fact pointing to the imminent insolvency of the customer or that compromises his creditworthiness, we reserve the right to regard the contract as terminated by operation of law and without prior notice of default, without prejudice to our right to compensation.

5.7. The delivered goods remain our property until full payment of the principal sum and ancillary sums. In the event of resale, we reserve the right to claim the sum that corresponds to the value of the goods resold. The retention of title is transferred to the resale price. Once the goods have been delivered, the customer bears all risks, even in the event of force majeure, and bears the duty to store them.

5.8. If, at any time, we have doubts about the creditworthiness of the customer due to acts of judicial execution against him, in the event of non-payment or late payment of one or more invoices and/or any other demonstrable event, we expressly reserve the right, even after partial delivery, to request additional guarantees from the customer in the absence of which we can immediately dissolve the agreement at his expense, without prejudice to compensation within the meaning of article 6.2.

5.9. A complaint does not suspend the customer's payment obligations.

Cancellation of the order / Termination of the agreement

6.1. In the event of default on the part of the customer, we have the choice either to demand the compulsory performance of the contract or to dissolve the contract at the expense of the customer, all this with compensation.

6.2. In all cases where the agreement is cancelled by the customer or is dissolved at his expense, he shall owe us, by operation of law and without prior notice of default, a fixed compensation of 40% of the price of the goods, without prejudice to our right to prove a higher loss. In the case of goods specifically manufactured for him, the compensation shall be 100% of the price. In the event of cancellation by the customer or dissolution of the agreement at his expense for standard goods before delivery but after cutting in our company, the compensation will amount to 75% of the price. In the event of cancellation or dissolution of the agreement at the expense of the customer after delivery for lengths less than 3 running metres, the compensation shall amount to 100% of the price.

Applicable law, jurisdiction

7.1. For all disputes, only the courts at Kortrijk have jurisdiction, without prejudice to our right to have the dispute settled by the court of the customer's place of residence.

7.2. Belgian law is applicable to the exclusion of the Vienna Sales Convention.
