AFTER INSTALLATION

To get the best performance from your flooring you should care for it properly as soon as it is fitted

Here are some tips



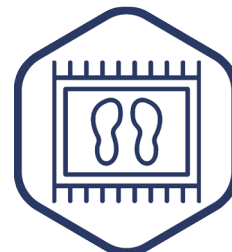
Once your new floor is down, it's important to give it time to settle. Leave it for 24 hours for the adhesive to dry. During this time, try not to clean the floor or move furniture back in. This also lets it adjust to the climate of the room which will minimize the risk of warping after installation.



Whether you're moving heavy appliances like fridge freezers or having other work done nearby, it's a good idea to protect your floor with something like a thin sheet of hardboard. When you're ready to bring furniture back, lift it rather than drag it to avoid damage, and take care when placing it down.



Adding felt pads to the feet of chairs and tables is a great way to help protect your floor from scratches. Also if you've set up a home office in your space with LVT or Laminate flooring, try to avoid furniture with wheels, as these will cause dents and marks over time.



To help keep your floor looking its best, place a good quality mat at your entrances to catch dirt and grit before they have a chance to spread. A door mat will also help reduce the chance of moisture seeping into the floors as it will absorb the water.

CARING FOR YOUR FLOOR

SIMPLE ROUTINES FOR LONG-LASTING BEAUTY

LVT

Daily/Weekly

Sweep with a soft bristle brush

Every 1–2 days to keep surfaces clear of debris that can cause minor marks or scratches.

Damp mop weekly using an LVT-friendly PH balanced cleaner.

Avoid overly wet mops – too much moisture can affect the layers beneath.



Spills & Stains

LVT is stain resistant and most stains lift easily – Blot any accidental spillages immediately for food marks clean with a clean absorbent cloth. Remove dry or hardened substances with a plastic spatula.

Greasy residues? Add a few drops of lemon juice to warm water for a natural clean.

LAMINATE

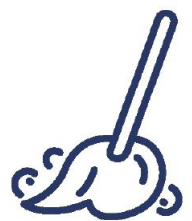
Daily/Weekly

Sweep regularly

This keeps grit from scratching the surface. Damp mop only when needed, using a laminate-safe PH cleaner and a well wrung mop.

Never use steam cleaners or soak the floor

By using high heat and pressure with a steam mop, moisture will be forced down into the joints and lower layers, which can damage the floor. Our 12mm Exquisite laminate range has 48 water protection, however water, if left to soak can damage laminate flooring.



VINYL

Daily/Weekly

Stain Removal

Most marks can be removed with a diluted cleaner and soft cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive pads that can scratch the surface.

Sweep or vacuum frequently

Use a mild detergent or vinyl floor cleaner with warm water for weekly mopping. Cleaners that contain harsh chemicals can permanently damage the surface. It is best to spot test any cleaner before using them on your floor. Rinse well and avoid excess water to prevent lifting at the edges.
